To whom it may concern:

It is my pleasure to discuss my experiences with SilverStream. This is a wound cleanser, and anti-microbial dressing agent that we have been using in our clinic for over 6 years.  - SilverStream contains Tween 20, an excellent surfactant and detergent that helps to bind necrotic debris and silver, which helps to kill the bacteria
- It is available in small bottles
 - This makes it easy to provide at a reasonable cost to our patients
- It is compatible with our advanced biologics treatments
 - Prior to application of biologics such as Apligraf, Theraskin, or Graftax, we will clean the surface of the wound. We find that this type of wound bed prep, in combination with debridement, is essential for success with the biologics.
